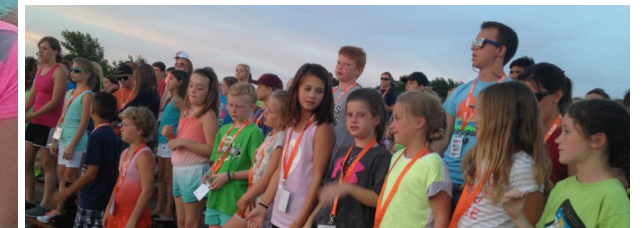
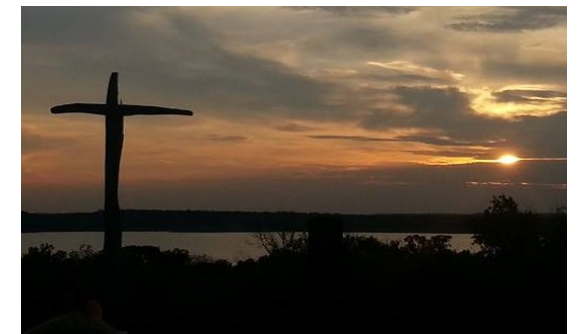

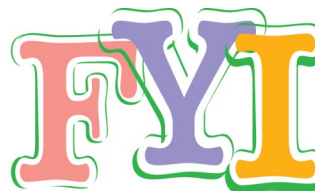

A New School Year and a New Comfort Zone in God's Kingdom

- * The church is recruiting for Holy Conversations, a process for asking "Who are we?" "What are we called to do?" and "What do we have the passion to pursue?" 6 to 8 committed church members will be needed to listen, gather data, and interact with the facilitator, Rev. John Thornburg from Texas Methodist Foundation Leadership Development for churches, to share information as we discern with new spirit and purpose the work God calls FUMC Burk to do.
- * I am recruiting 8 to 10 individuals for long term leadership development through the Healthy Church Initiative. We will read and dialogue with lay people and pastors from area UMCs with similar demographics about benchmarks to keep the church relevant and vital. If you are interested, ask me about it!
