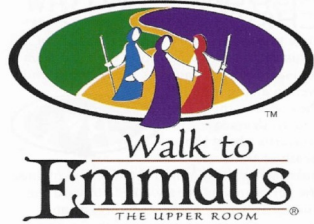

**Women's Walk to Emmaus  
 October 15-18 in Burkburnett**



The walk to Emmaus is an experience of Christian spiritual renewal and formation that begins with a three-day short course in Christianity. It is an opportunity to meet Jesus Christ in a new way as God's grace and love is revealed to you through other believers.

The Walk to Emmaus experience begins with the prayerful discernment and invitation from a sponsor. After one accepts this invitation they complete an application. The Emmaus leaders prayerfully consider each applicant and in God's time, the person is invited to attend a three-day experience of New Testament Christianity as a lifestyle.

Through the formational process of accountable discipleship in small groups and participation in the Emmaus community, each participant's individual gifts and servant-leadership skills are developed for use in the local church and its mission. Participants are encouraged to find ways to live out their individual call to discipleship in their home, church, and community.

The objective of Emmaus is to inspire, challenge, and equip the local church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, communities and places of work. Emmaus lifts up a way for our grace-filled lives to be lived and shared with others. Call the church office or speak with Pastor Liz if you are interested.

**The Beggar's Corner**

“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.” Psalm 119:105

Repeat after me: “Prayer is in schools and in the workplace when the church is in prayer.” “The Gospel is in the believer when the believer is in the bible.”

Keep repeating these until you know it to be true!

I pray that you have been in the scriptures this week! I think the bible presentation to the 3<sup>rd</sup> graders on Sunday Aug. 30 is a great motivator to get back into the word if a busy schedule has weakened your resolve or clouded your priorities.

My own journey has focused around scriptures dealing with meals and sharing the gospel as I frantically prepare for the written part of my Doctorate of Ministry project to be turned in by the first of October. I recommend Luke as a great gospel rich with hospitality, evangelism, and the healing practices of prayer, profession of the Lordship of Jesus Christ, and promoting the gospel through word and deed. But my favorite scriptures are Micah 6:8, Matthew 7:7, and Philippians 2:13. Although I have many more that become meaningful depending on my season of life!

To assist the new bible owners and to nurture all people, especially young and new believers into abundant, life-giving relationships with God through Jesus Christ (which is the most important thing the church ever does!) I ask that you join me in compiling a list of our favorite verses for the children and even the adults of our church. This list will assist them in getting familiar with the scriptures. Your favorite verse may become the child's favorite “go to” verse for the variety of circumstances life affords and you may be a channel of God's presence in our children's lives.

Please select your favorite verse and call the office, bring it by, mail it in, or jot it down on Sunday on the attendance pad. Thank you to everyone who turned in a verse last Sunday! Your response was great! We want to encourage everyone to participate. And we will furnish copies of this list to everyone as we complete the list.
